It's 1834 in the southern plantation slave state of Louisiana. When the new school teacher, Scottish-Canadian slavery abolitionist William King, arrives to take up his post and to engage in the fight against slavery he quickly becomes involved in a 30-year odyssey to found a haven in Canada for escaped U.S. slaves.

Heritage Pavilion Stage of Peterborough is pleased to present a 1-week, 10-performance school tour of the historical play, And Freedom For All, from February 4-8, 2008.

And Freedom For All is the moving story of the Underground Railway, based on the true story of the Scottish-Canadian missionary and teacher William King and a group of courageous slaves. They escaped with him to freedom to found a haven in the community of Chatham, Ontario for other U.S. fugitives. From them, King learned the true meaning of freedom.



This professionally-produced, fast-paced, curriculum-linked, 45-minute history play, written by Peterborough playwright and elementary school teacher **Ed Schroeter, is geared to students in Grades 4 to 12.** It is strongly linked to the Grade 7 (British North America) and Grade 8 (Confederation) history curricula, but the play's themes of democracy and justice are timeless.

This tour is being done in conjunction with public performances at St. Andrew's Church in South Buxton, the actual site of some of the events 150 years ago.
